MAJOR OUTCOME OF THE MEETING

The Publicly Available Specification ISO/PAS 28000:2005 "Security Management System for the Supply Chain" was approved and published in November, the last year. At this meeting, the working group discussed the draft guidelines for the implementation of ISO/PAS 28000:2005 and developed the first draft of the guidelines (ISO/PAS 28004).

The group further discussed the necessity of the ISO standard on the requirements for certification bodies which will be in charge of third-party auditing in accordance with ISO/PAS 28000 and ISO/PAS 28001 "Specification for implementing supply chain security management, assessment and plans- Requirements and guidance" (not yet officially approved as PAS.) Then the group agreed to recommend the Technical Committee (ISO/TC 8) to start the development of such standard.

MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS

Dr. Ota contributed to refine the draft ISO/PAS, in particular from the view points of clarification and consistency.

During the meeting, the working group was separated into three small groups to speed up the consideration on the preliminary draft. Dr. Ota considered the paragraphs on "security risk assessment and planning" and contributed, in particular, to the improvement of the relevant expressions, based on the knowledge on the risk assessment and other regulations and standards for security.
